



## In-home Respite Care

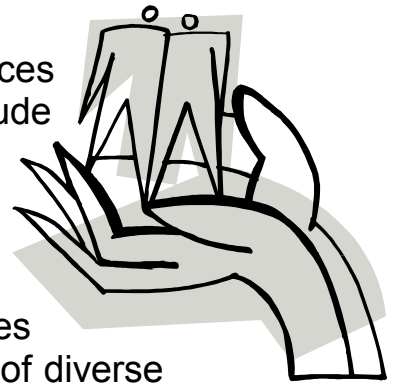
***Support for carers of people with dementia, those who are frail aged or younger people with a disability***

Bromilow Home Support Services is able to offer the carers of people with dementia, the carers of people who are frail aged and the carers of younger disabled people, access to in-home respite care.

This care program is funded by the Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing's National Respite for Carers' Program (NRCP).

The aim of the NRCP is to contribute to the support and maintenance of caring relationships between carers and their dependent family members or friends by facilitating access to respite care and other support appropriate to their individual needs and circumstances, and those of the people for whom they care.

Bromilow's in-home respite services are very flexible. Services are available 365 days a year. Respite care may also include support with personal care and household tasks such as cleaning, ironing and shopping or assistance to access community activities and interests.



Services are arranged in full consultation with carers. Services are designed to flexibly and responsively address the variety of diverse needs that carers may have.

The maximum fee for in-home respite care under the NRCP is \$7.50 per hour. (Or \$10.00 per hour weekends) Inability to afford the full fee does not prevent carers from accessing NRCP services.
