The current delivery is through a number of simple clear workbooks on a range of practice interests and needs. Practices can choose to do one workbook or all of them. They are self paced and provide *easy access to resources and education*.

The books have a simple, clear design and plans/actions that are not difficult to implement and are designed to work within the GP environment by not impacting heavily on practices time and resources.
