


ADDING A PAP SMEAR RESULT (BP)

You can add a papsmear result from two places

1. From the 'Inbox'

From the results inbox the GP can 'Add Smear'

This will bring up the 'cervical smear result' screen, from here the GP can also add the recall reminder for either follow-up or routine reminder for two years time.



Choose the GP – 'To see:'

Choose the reminder reason and reminder interval from number of weeks or choose a date
'Remind in:'

Set a routine reminder for "Pap Screening" in 2 years for normal results

Or for those requiring follow up

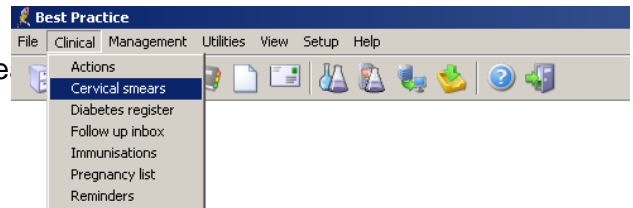
Set a recall for "Pap Abnormal" in a month or shorter
depending on the urgency

If you tick 'Automatically update reminder when sent to the patient' this will recognise that once printed this recall is complete and a new recall is set for the chosen date e.g. two years time if a pap screening recall. If you choose to use this action you will need to ensure that your systems are designed to follow up "recalls" (those you are legally responsible to follow up with three contacts).

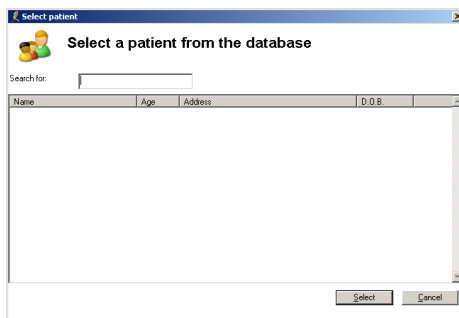
PAP SMEAR SEARCHES

Once you have recorded a smear MD3 provides the facility to search on the Interval a patient last had a smear or Customise your search to follow up on Abnormal results.

From the main screen select Clinical – Cervical Smear



From the 'Select Patient' screen, type in the patient surname and 'select'



This will open the 'cervical smears' screen for that patient
From here you can *view, add, edit and delete*

You can even open the patient file to add further notes or search related progress/ visit notes
