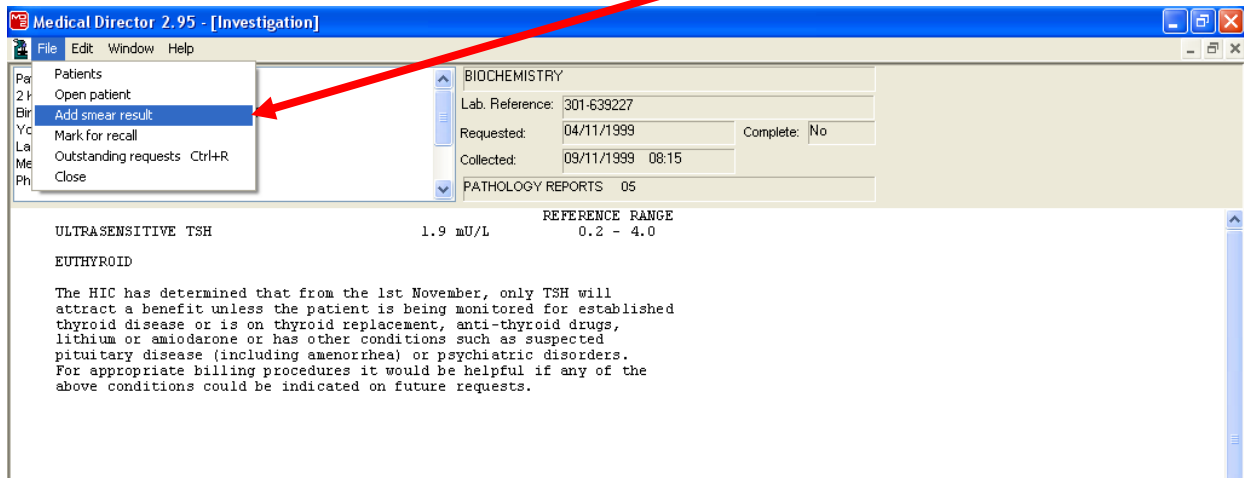



## ADDING A PAP SMEAR RESULT

## PAP SMEAR SEARCHES

Once you have recorded a smear MD3 provides the facility to search on the Interval a patient last had a smear or Customise your search to follow up on Abnormal results. **Search Menu<Pap Smear**
