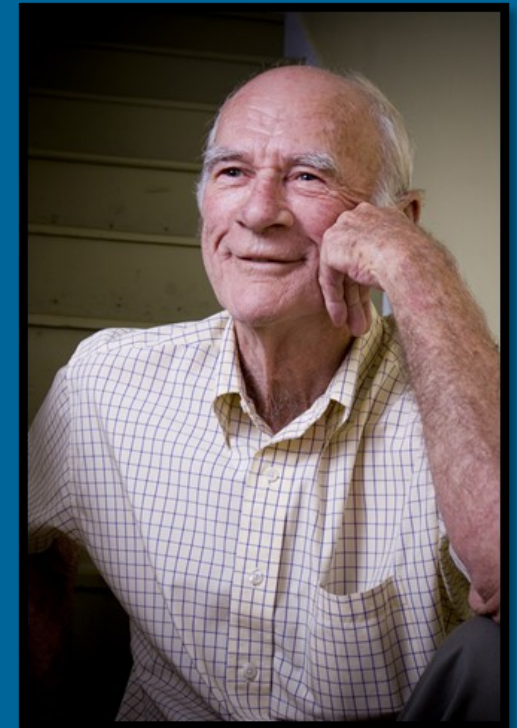

Shared Care Community Clinic -Gympie



You are invited to attend the Shared Care Community Diabetes Clinic (SCCC). This is a new concept in diabetes care in the Gympie region. The SCCC clinic involves an Endocrinologist (Diabetes Specialist) visiting your regular doctors practice to see you and your GP.

To assist the GP and the Endocrinologist with your diabetes care, the practice nurse and a visiting Diabetes Educator will complete a thorough diabetes assessment two weeks prior to the clinic (pre-clinic). The assessment will involve you making decisions and setting your goals for your future health.



What do I do next?

- *Mark your appointment time on your calendar;*
- *Partners, spouses and carers are most welcome to attend the appointments;*
- *Bring an up-to-date medication list, including any over the counter medications e.g. herbal supplements, vitamins;*
- *Bring your glucose meter, glucose diary and insulin device/s;*
- *Don't forget to bring your prescription glasses;*
- *Bring your completed Patient Survey Questionnaire;*
- *Questions you may like answered by your GP, Specialist or nurse write them down and bring them with you.*
