Standing Drug Order (SDO)

The applicability of the Standing Drug Order to nurses working in private practice will depend on the individual arrangements that practices have in place for these nurses. Applicability cannot be assumed and GPs should obtain independent advice on this matter if desired.

Adverse Event Following Immunisation (AEFI) Reporting

A number of AEFI forms have been submitted without details of the person submitting the report being completed. This creates difficulty if additional information is required and the vaccine service provider can not be identified. Please ensure the following section of the adverse reaction form is completed.
